

Our bodies are permeable; they are the first environment through which we experience the multispecies world and co-create a complex organism.


Like a bolt from the blue, we are struck by illnesses and processes that are not always welcome.

Exercises in patience is a series that refers to humble, routinely repeated actions — carried out with care and tenderness — that cultivate well-being.










Composition of the Air

Something`s bugging me

installation of many small objects made of leaves, sticks, wood, acrylic, beewax and wire 2023

Floating in space – microparticles and debris, pollutants, and allergens – circulates in the air and goes to our respiratory systems.

Subnature according to the definition of the author of the book "Subnature. Architectural other environments" – David Gissen refers to things such as dankness, darkness, mud, weeds, smoke, puddles, dust, debris, crowds, and pigeons. It includes also smog, exhaust gas, and industrial smoke. Therefore, with each breath, we come into contact with socially regarded as the less attractive or undesirable part of nature. Trying to protect ourselves from it, we can become threatened by what we need the most – the air.

In my installation, I try to present it pleasantly and positively. The idea for the installation arose at the time of my increased suffering from allergies – I would like to create it to face the fear of pollen hiding in the space and attacking unexpectedly together with other pollution.



All thoughts I lost walking that way

A drawing traced across the sky, suspended between two hundred-year-old cherry trees, on the road from Tarczyn to Modrzewie — my cherished path to stillness, where thoughts settle and silence begins.



To the fragile plots our species are thrown

constantly changing installation in window, workshop and photo documentation of collected objects 2022

The sticks and leaves are nomads. Floating and ubiquitous. They roam the city, surrendering to the will of the wind, landing on sidewalks and squares. They lead their erratic lives bravely, no matter what the circumstances.

The changes in my places of life stop surprising me. I inevitably walk between new spaces and addresses. I tame them over and over again when the changing seasons pass in my veins. My fingers are unsuccessfully looking for ground in the fertile soil to take root.

When I touch particles of people and plants, I am surprised by the common tendency to create fragile forms of survival. In a repetitive cycle of constant changes, dispersing into a multitude of diverse states, unpredictability becomes the norm. Meeting among the intertwined fortunes, what is ordinary, is out of control. And the combination of tissue unstable and surprisingly resilient at the same time, nomadically forms a network of such strong connections.

The project was realized during a month's residency in Forma Otwarta in Olesnica in cooperation with the Art House Foundation, in June 2022. It combines creating a constantly changing window installation, workshops, and public presentation of the art process













What a beautiful disaster

installation and objects made of sticks and leaves, threads, wires and acrylic 2022 The project was presented at the exhibition Intimate Rituals in OP ENHEIM in Wroclaw, in Spring of 2022, as a summary of OP_Young programme for emerging artist.

Scientific data and facts typically appear to us as abstract creations that are difficult to interpret properly. Due to the media noise and information dialogue, we are flooded with a whole raft of contradictory messages that effectively preclude us from finding reliable answers to important questions, such as the condition of modern man or the climate emergency. When processing the contents fed to us on a daily basis, we rely on the subjectivity and sensitivity of our perception, which, however, is increasingly distorted by manipulated data, fake news, incomplete information and media noise. So where to look for the truth? The network becomes our natural habitat. It is a creation based on antinomies, in which labyrinthine thoughts, abstract data, infatuation with consumerism and processed images of nature are mixed with the romantic, unbridled longing to the unspoiled, natural world and the need to commune with it



The crisis of the lack of respite for the eyes filled with commercial reality – is the factor that triggered a need in me to create a project based on finding elements of nature in a remote location from the urban fabric and processing them into pastel objects, alluding to happiness propagated in the media. To emphasize this fragility and ephemeral nature, which seems like a dream come true.

The project was created during the art residence at The Sheep with a View Creative Recreation Center in Spalona in the Bystrzyckie Mountains, in October 2021.

set of objects sticks, leaves, threads, acrylic 2020


My assumption is to use only what is waste. Natural waste. I don't break anything, I don't cut anything. I use found items lying somewhere on the ground waiting to decompose.


These objects represent my general attitude to the realization of artifacts in which the concept and the creative process are important. The process is not only about cleaning, applying paint or cutting the right shape. An important part of it are travels, during which I find inspiring fragments of nature.

They are also ephemeral objects because of their properties – more or less depending on the material. An interesting phenomenon is change. Thanks to fading away, there is a space for what is new.

Project was presented at the diploma exhibition "Sticks and dashes, naturally" in JEST gallery in Wroclaw.












t/s Franken

installation videoloop, petrol, audio 1:57 min, 2019 t/s Franken is a German supplier from World War II, sunk on May 8, 1945 near Hel. It is estimated that the tanker, over 180 m long and 22.1 m wide, contains 1.5 million liters of fuel. As a result of the progressive corrosion, an ecological disaster can occur at any time. Severe contamination will affect the coast and beaches in the Bay of Gdańsk region.
